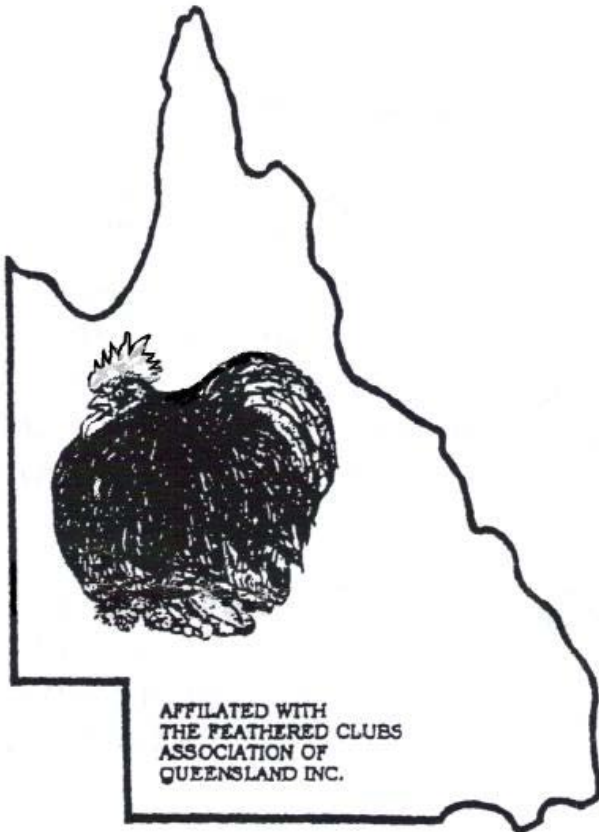

3. Each Junior exhibitor will receive a Commended Certificate.

## **GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS**

1. Individual birds in pairs are not eligible for open Championship awards.
2. All birds entered in the AOC classes must have their colour marked on the entry form and come from an accepted recognised standard.
3. Separate colour classes will be made when there are four (4) or more entries.
4. Champion of each colour will be awarded a Sash and will only be awarded a Trophy in sections with six or more entries.
5. All QLD exhibitors must be financial members of the FCAQ
6. Entry fees must accompany entries. All cheques are to be made out to "The Pekin Club of Queensland."
7. All entries should be posted to the Secretary and received by due date.
8. All birds are to be penned by 8.20am. Birds may be penned on the Friday between 2pm & 8pm or on Saturday between 5.30am and 8.20am (Please mark your choice on the entry form)

### **Judging to commence at 8.30am.**

9. No birds to be released until after the presentation of Trophies (about 3.00pm).
10. A second judge may be called upon depending on entry numbers executive committee to decide if required.
- 11 In the event of a dispute it must be lodged with the Chief Steward.
12. All care will be taken, but the club **will not** be responsible for loses or damage caused to exhibits prior, during and after the show.
13. Exhibitors own water/feed containers are not permitted in pens during judging.
14. The club reserves the right to photograph any entry
15. Reserve Champion Cards will be awarded to each Colour where there are eight or more entries
16. Only birds entered in the show can be sold in the pavilion
17. Any member or exhibitor who shall be guilty of conduct derogatory to this club may be expelled from exhibiting at the show or future shows.
